<b>Daniel 5:26-28</b>	Another episode in the book of Daniel, God names the next ruling power after Babylon; the Medo-Persian empire.		
Isaiah 45:1	The Bible predicted the birth and activities of Cyrus. Cyrus led his armies to overthrow Babylon		
Jeremiah 51:37, 64	The Bible predicted that Babylon would fall and not rise again.		
Daniel 2:42, 43	Despots and diplomats would try and unite Europe but they would fail, because God said it would never happen.		
Daniel 2:44, 45	The next thing to happen is the return of Christ who will establish an everlasting kingdom that will never be destroyed.		
Revelation 11:15	The book of Revelation also reveals that Christ is going to set up a kingdom one day soon that will last forever.		
Revelation 21:4, 5	God's empire will be an empire with nor more tears, no more pain, and no more death. God is going to make it right. You can trust Him implicitly.
