Genesis 3:4	Satan is the author of the lie that when a person dies they're not really dead.
Hebrews 9:27	We die once. The idea of the soul being recycled is a myth.
Job 7:9, 10	The dead don't return to their previous home to haunt.
Revelation 16:13, 14	The spirits of devils deceive many people.
Deuteronomy 18:10-12	It is dangerous to seek to contact the dead.
