

Demonic Dimensions: The Emperors Night Cry

STUDY GUIDE NO. 20

- Revelation 17:3-5** John sees a prostitute riding a scarlet colored beast. Her name is Mystery Babylon.
- Revelation 12:1-5** John also sees a women clothed with the sun with the moon under her feet.
- Jeremiah 6:2** A woman in Bible prophecy represents God's people.
- 2 Corinthians 11:2** Paul likens God's faithful people to a chaste virgin woman.
- James 4:4** Christians belonging to the world while professing love for Christ are likened to adulterers.
- Revelation 16:19, 13** Babylon is comprised of three parts:
1. Dragon – systems of religion opposed to God's word.
2. Sea Beast – the Papacy
3. Land Beast – apostate Protestantism in the U.S.
- Revelation 17:4** Babylon has made all nations drunk with her wine, or false teachings (see (Luke 5:37).
- 1 Timothy 4:1** Paul predicted that false doctrines would abound in the last days.
- Revelation 14:8** Babylon is fallen because of her corruption and false teachings.
- Revelation 16:13, 14, 18** The three powers of Babylon gather everyone to the Battle of Armageddon.
- Revelation 13:4, 12-14** Deceptive signs and wonders will lead the world to follow Babylon. This is just what Satan has wanted from the beginning. When a person worships the beast, they actually worship him.
- Signs in the world – a marked interest in the supernatural seen in movies and books.
Signs in the Papacy – Marian apparitions and worship abound.
Signs in apostate Protestantism – healings and prophecy movement is gaining momentum.
- Matthew 7:22, 23** Many will profess to serve God in the last days, but will be lost because they failed to obey Him.
- Matthew 7:15, 16** We can know if someone is of God or the enemy by the fruit of their lives.
- Isaiah 8:20** We can know someone is of God or the enemy by what they teach and what their attitude is to the law of God.
- Matthew 7:21** Those who do the will of God will be saved at last.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:9, 10** We can avoid demonic deceptions by knowing and loving the truth.

- Revelation 18:1-5** God is calling His people out of Babylon lest they receive of her plagues and destruction.
- Revelation 12:17** God is calling His people out of Babylon into His remnant.
- Romans 11:2-5** A remnant represents those who are faithful to God in the midst of unfaithfulness (see Revelation 12:17; 14:1, 4).
- Isaiah 10:22** A remnant represents those who are left after God's wrath has been poured out (see Revelation 16:19; 6:16, 17; 7:10, 14).
- Jeremiah 51:45** A remnant represents those who are obedient to the call to come out of Babylon (see Revelation 18:4).
