- Hebrews 11:13, 14, 16** Paul speaks of the royal line of faith who looked forward to a wonderful new world.
- Hebrews 11:24-26** So sure was Moses of the marvelous future that God promised that he turned down all the wealth and pleasures of the opulent Egyptian palace.
- 2 Peter 3:13** Peter looked forward to the time when God would make a new heavens and a new earth.
- Acts 3:20, 21** Peter preached about the time when God would restore all things as they were before sin.
- Hebrews 12:1, 2** We need to keep our eyes focused on the joy that is set before us as Jesus did.
- 1 Corinthians 2:9** Words are absolutely inadequate to express the beauties of the new world.
- Isaiah 60:18** The new world will be a world of eternal peace.
- Isaiah 11:9** Imagine a world with no more war, no more violence, no more abuse.
- Isaiah 33:24** The new world will be a place of eternal health
- Isaiah 35:5, 6** No more blindness and glasses. No more deafness and hearing devices. No more hospitals and wheelchairs. No more speech impediments. What a place the new world is going to be!
- Philippians 3:20, 21** When Jesus returns we will receive new bodies like His glorious body.
- Revelation 21:4** The new world will be a place of eternal life. No more tears, pain, sin, or death!
- Isaiah 35:1** The new world will be a place of eternal beauty.
- Isaiah 65:21** The new world will be a place of eternal creativity.
- Isaiah 35:10** The new world will be a place of eternal joy.
- Isaiah 66:23** The new world will be a place of eternal Sabbath fellowship.
- John 14:1-3** When Jesus returns we go to heaven with Him. We will be there for 1,000 years, then come down to a new earth to live here forever (see Rev. 20:5, 6; 21:2; Matt. 5:5).
- Revelation 21:16, 17** The New Jerusalem is 1,500 miles in parameter. That's 375 miles on each side. Plenty of room inside for all who want to be there.
- Revelation 21:21** Each of the twelve gates are made of one giant pearl. Perhaps one of the reasons God informs us that there will be twelve gates, is because He wants us to know there is abundant entrance into His kingdom.

Revelation 21:12 Perhaps God is telling us through the fact that the apostles names are on the foundations, that if Christ's followers with all their faults can make it – so can you!

Revelation 21:19, 21 The city is valuable because God considers us to be valuable.

Revelation 21:3; 22:3, 4 The most amazing thing about the new world is that God Himself will live with us here!

Revelation 21:27 We can have a place in the new world if our names are written in the Lamb's book of life

1 John 5:11, 12 If you have the Son, you have eternal life.

Revelation 22:19 Our names can come out of the book of life.
