2	reminded King Belshazzar of Daniel? Why does Daniel recount when Nebuchadnezzar became like a wild beast?

	Belshazzar, saying that this showed his heart was lifted up against the Lord of heaven?
3.	What was done with Daniel when he interpreted the handwriting?

Read I	Daniel 9 – Daniel's prayer and the 490 years of Jewish Probation
1.	What prophecy of Jeremiah was Daniel considering as he began his prayer?

2	What was Daniel so concerned about at this time especially?
4.	Who came to explain things to Daniel? According to verse 23, a previous vision is about to be explained. What vision would that be? What part of that
	vision did Daniel not understand?

	Daniel's prayer? How much time would the Jews get to fulfill their purpose and be ready to receive the
	Messiah?
5.	What would mark the starting point for this time prophecy? What
	would happen after 69 weeks in the middle of the 70 th week?
Read	Daniel 10-12 – Daniel's Vision of the Kings of the North and South to the Last Days
1.	Who did Daniel meet in 10:5-9 (see Rev. 1:13-16 for help)? It becomes clear in the
	following verses that the individual that touches him and helps him up in verse 10 is different from the
	one who came to him in verses 5-9. Who do you think this is? What was the prince of
	the kingdom of Persia (Cyrus) supposed to do but wouldn't for the past 21 days (think about Daniel's
	main concern)? Who came to personally deal with Cyrus (see
	also 2 Chronicles 26:22, 22\2
	Who is the mighty king in 11:3? How does verse 4 fit the Greek Empire?
	Why does verse 20 fit the time of Rome and the
	birth of Jesus?
	Who is the prince of the covenant who was broken in verse 22? What characteristic of
	the papacy do you see in verse 33? What trait of the papacy do
	you see in verse 36? 37?

	When is the "time of the end" in verse 40 (see Dan. 12:6-7)?
	Note : The king of the south pushing at him in vs. 40 is the deadly wound of Rev. 13:3. Verses 40-45 are
	considered by most people to be unfulfilled prophecy. This passage flows into 12:1-2 which describes
	the close of probation and the second coming. What do you think that Dan. 11:40-45 is all about?
5.	What words mean the close of human probation in Daniel 12:1? How
	does verse 2 connect to the second coming of Christ? For how long was
	the book of Daniel to be sealed? Why are verses 6-7 a key to unlocking
	Bible prophecy? What are the lengths of the final two
	prophecies in verses 11-12? Do you know what these mean?
Read 2	2 Chronicles 36:22-23 and Ezra 1-2 – The Jews Allowed to Organize to Return to Judah
1.	Who decided to authorize the building of a new temple in Jerusalem? What prophecy
	was fulfilled by this proclamation? What did Cyrus call for in
	Ezra 1:3? What was returned to the
	Jews to take back to Jerusalem?
2.	For what purpose was the long list of people given in Ezra 2:1-63?
	How many people departed from the province of Babylon?
	. Who led the expedition back to Judah?
